## From The Chair

The SUN CITY FIREWISE GROUP held a Town Hall on October 8. This was during the week of October 6-12 which was Fire Prevention Week as a NFPA campaign.

The National Fire Protection Association reflects the date in history of the great Chicago fire of 1871. NFPA wants to raise awareness for fire safety. Sun City FIREWISE Group holds the annual Town Hall with that aim. The video of the 2024 Meeting will be posted.

Fire departments across the U.S. provide education for fire safety and encourage families to practice fire prevention. Households can practice fire drills, escape plans and designated meeting places after they have gotten out of the house. Captain Eric Lambert of Georgetown Fire Department gave a speech about smoke alarms. Top points are:

- \* to check the test button plus replace the batteries at least annually.
- \* replace smoke alarms every 10 years or according to the manufacture's guideline.
  - \* Be careful how electric extension cords are used.
  - \* Replace damaged cords/holiday lights.

Holiday cooking season is upon us. Think about fire safety this season.
