

SCARS Assistance In The Sale Of Amateur Radio Equipment

(Adopted: June 3, 2015)

Assistance To A Surviving Spouse

1. If requested by the surviving spouse of a deceased SCARS member, 2 or more SCARS members working together as an informal "silent key(SK) estate advisory team" will assist the surviving spouse with inventorying and pricing the deceased member's ham equipment.
2. SCARS will make available to its members via email all or any portion of the inventory as directed by the surviving spouse.
3. The inventory distributed, in addition to the listing and price for each item offered for sale, must contain the following information:
 - a. Seller's contact information (name, phone number and email address).
 - b. A statement that all items are sold "As Is" unless a warranty is intended, in which case the warranty shall be described.
 - c. A statement that SCARS is distributing the information as a courtesy only and that SCARS is not otherwise involved in the sale.
4. SCARS will not store, test, demonstrate or deliver the items nor be involved in any way in the negotiation or sale of any of the items.
5. If requested by the surviving spouse, SCARS will make the inventory list available twice. The second email shall be 2 to 4 weeks after the initial email. The second list shall be updated by the surviving spouse showing what items remain available for sale.
6. SCARS in its sole discretion may set other conditions it deems appropriate under the circumstances.

Assistance To All Others

SCARS, in its sole discretion and subject to such conditions it deems appropriate, may make available to its members a list of items offered for sale by other persons. At a minimum the seller will be required to meet the conditions set forth above for a sale by a surviving spouse. The inventory list will be made available to SCARS members one time only.

General

SCARS recommends all sellers contact other Ham clubs to have the inventory list distributed to its members in addition to the distribution to SCARS members.
