I love color and I'm fascinated by how color is used in our everyday life.

Did you know that Sherwin Williams has 1700 colors to choose from and can match almost any color you could dream up. Our eyes, however, can see 100 shades of EACH color which amounts to 1 million colors.

Color impacts how we experience the world around us.

Red is used on emergency vehicles, fire trucks and stop signs because it is bold and evokes urgency and is a reactive color.

Yellow gives you a sense of caution and is the first color that catches our attention. Great for advertisements, school buses, and stripes on the highway.

Green is used on highway signs because green is the last color that disappears in poor visibility. The human eye sees more shades of green than any other color.

Blue is used a lot in advertising to convey trust, stability, loyalty, security, and calmness. To name a few, Banks, insurance companies, and news channels use blue in their logos. Blue is a color that can influence up to 90% of a customer's first impression.

Orange is used on life jackets, traffic cones, and tow truck lights and is considered a warning color. Advertising companies use it because it is a high energy color and is stimulating in a friendly way.

Violet is the creative color, need I say more. My favorite color.

How you use color in your art can transport the viewer to a place that they have never been before. Color can bring the viewer excitement, mystery, sadness, calmness, or just their happy place.

All the great artists used color to pull the viewer into their world. Vincent Van Gogh wrote "the painter of the future will be a colorist the like of which has never yet been seen. But I'm sure I am right to think that it will come in a later generation, and it is up to us to do all we can to encourage it, without question or complaint."

Laura Fox-Wallis will be our presenter at the June 11th General Meeting at 2pm in the Longhorn room at the Retreat Center. You will not want to miss her demo of how she paints on silk.
