# THE APP TO SAVE US FROM PANDEMIC PANDEMONIUM

PANDEMICs are nothing to be sniffed at. "A flu pandemic will spread through the world so quickly that we won't be able to make vaccines quickly enough," says mathematician Dr Hannah Fry. The first line of defence, therefore, is tech.

Fry and Dr Javid Abdelmoneim have built the BBC Pandemic app to help plot how a disease would spread (a 90-minute associated documentary, BBC Pandemic, will air in spring 2018 on BBC Four). It is free to download and anonymously tracks your location over 24 hours, recording who you have met, and uses the information for the greater good.

"We don't get a trial run for this, it's a case of when not if," says Fry. "When it does happen we need to be able to make sure we're making the right decisions at the right times: should we close the schools and the airports? How many hospital beds do we need?" The Government National Risk Register estimates that infectious diseases are an even greater risk than terrorism.

So how does the app work? "To be able to create a mathematical simulation you need to know how often we come into contact with each other

Summing up: left, Dr Hannah Fry, who has designed Pandemic, far left



and how far people travel," says Fry. The information collected by researchers from Cambridge and the Hygiene and Tropical Medicine department is used to model how a real flu pandemic would spread across the country. It's important to have models we have built from 1,000 from 1,000 people in the dust. Abdelmoneim will be featured in the next year.
