Wall Street Journal Apple

- Passcode
- Steal phone passcode obtained prior to theft
- AppleID & iCloud Digital lives Financial lives
- Change AppleID, turn off Find My, access keychain, open photos to find SSN or DL, lock account of associated devices, change recovery key
- Now Apple protections prevent YOU from YOUR digital lives/data
- Apple cash
- SMS unlock code from bank to the stolen phone
- New Titanium Apple Pay card
- “Here, add your contact info to my phone”
- Or, record passcode entry
- Thief swap phones to delay detection

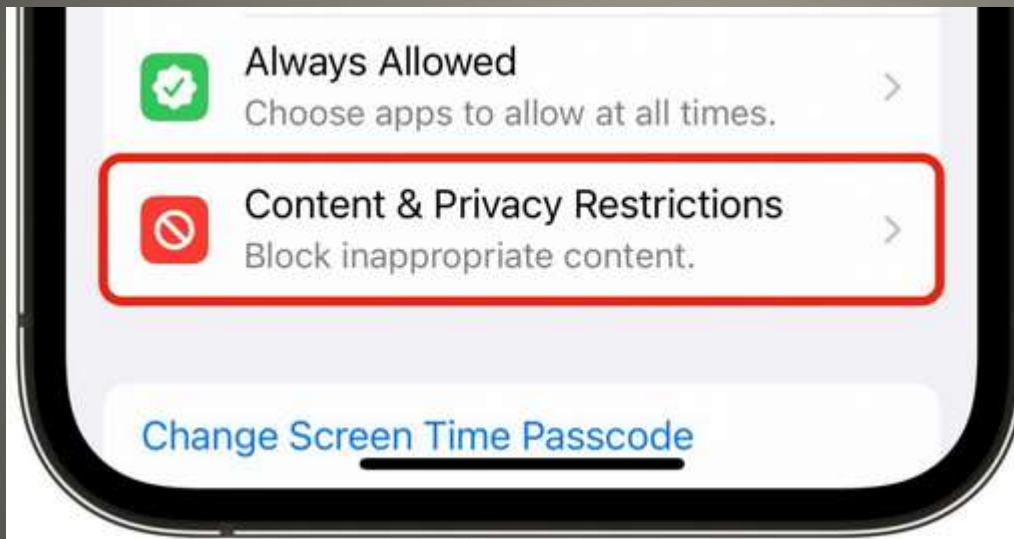
Smart Device



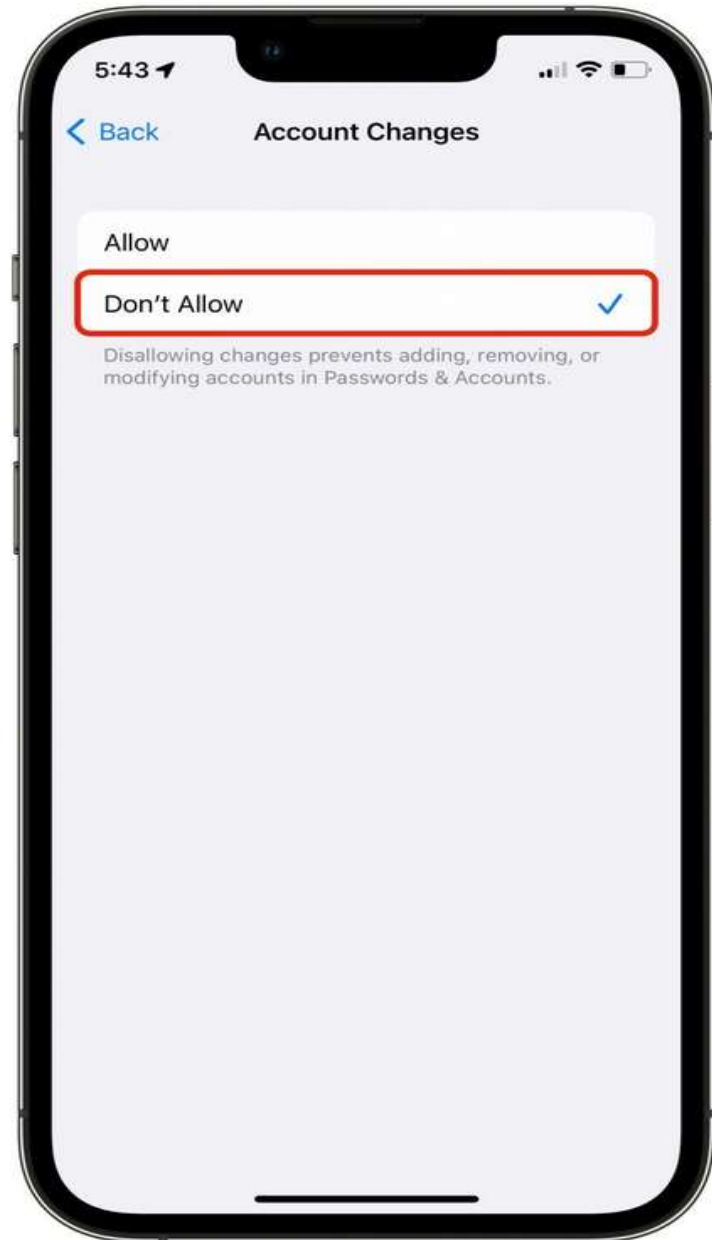
- STRONGER PASSCODES
- Max number of digits mixed with alphanumeric
- Treat passcode like ATM passcode
- Use increased protections (factors)
- Delete photos/scans with sensitive personal information
- Move to protected storage

General Protections

- Screen Time passcode to iCloud settings
- Settings > Screen Time > Content & Privacy Restrictions



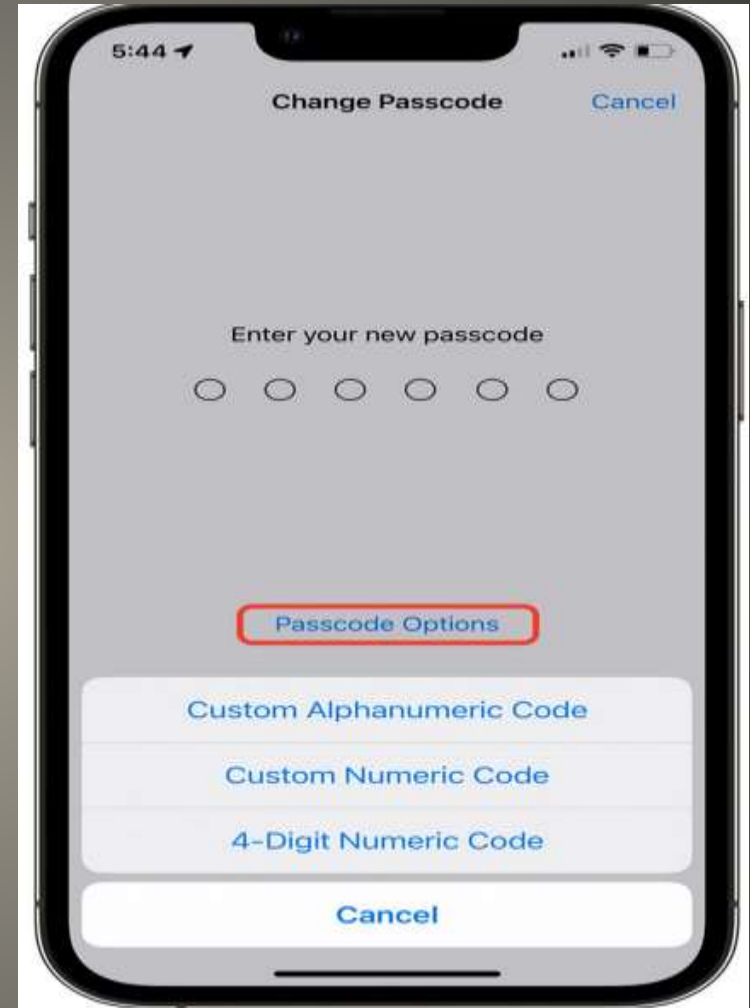

- iCloud email tainted?

Alias use

- iCloud login with AppleID
- Add Aliases(s)
- Click *Rules*
- Add a rule
- If a message - addressed to
- Enter tainted email address
- Move to Trash and Mark as read
- Mail to alias in Inbox
- Mail to tainted address in Trash folder
- Trash emptied
- HOWEVER iOS & macOS mail don't have rules
