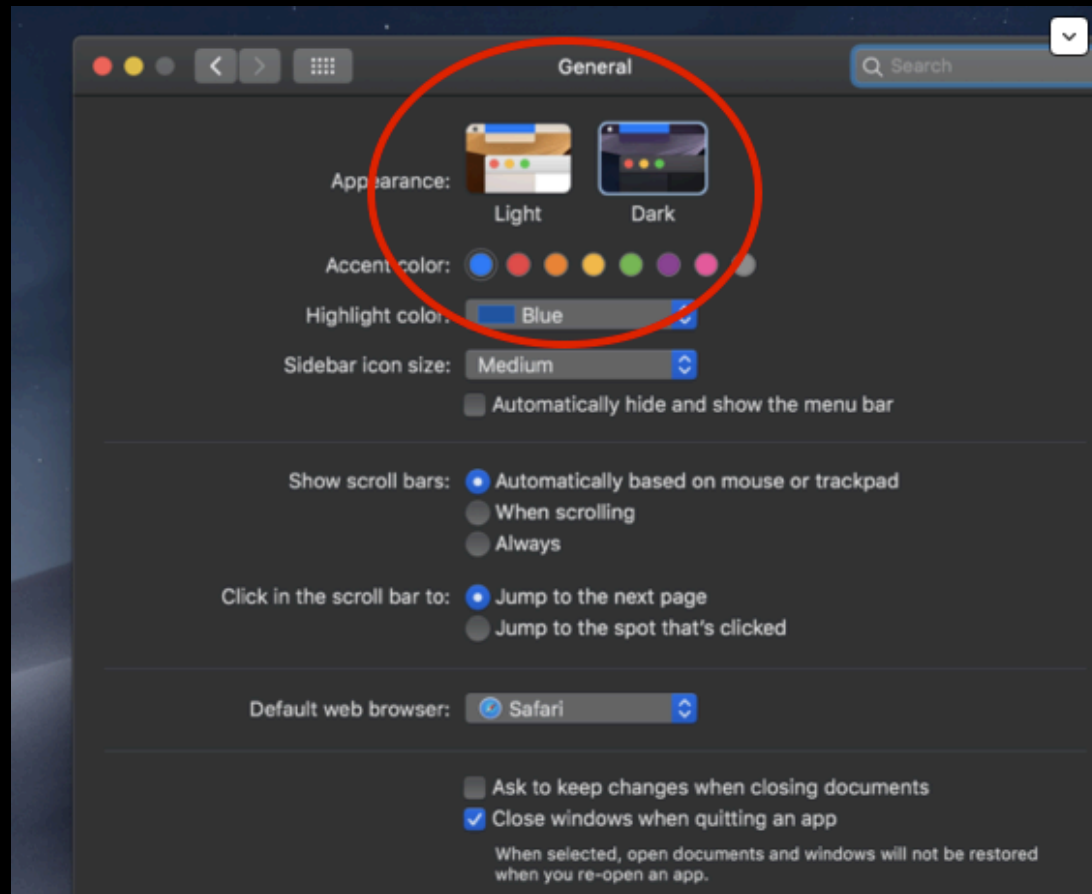

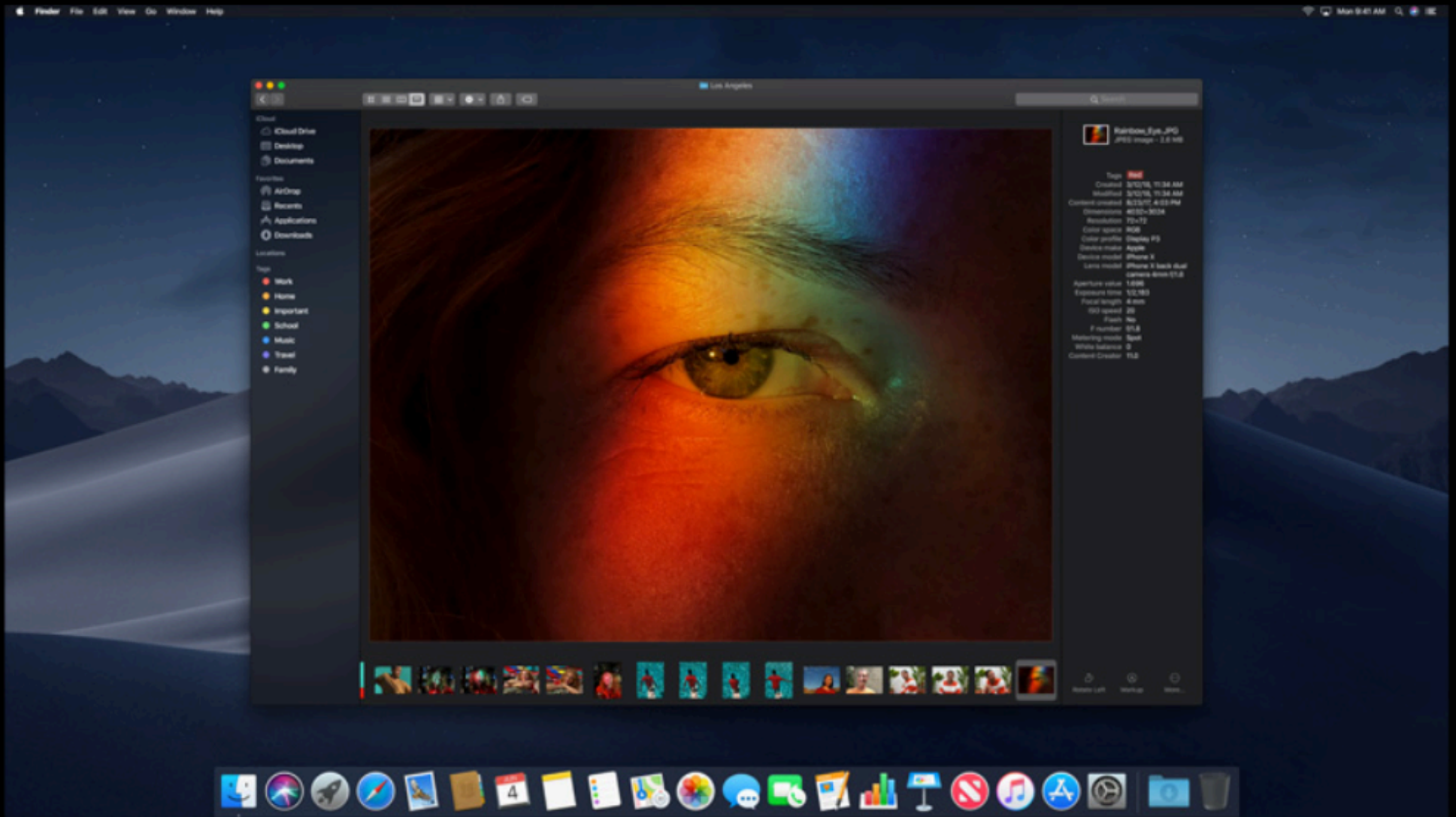

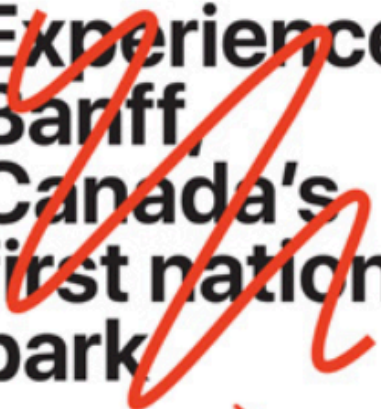

Banff is more than just the Canadian Rockies

Located in the Canadian Rocky Mountains, Banff is more than just a scenic gem—it's Canada's first national park and North America's first, after Yellowstone and Mackinac. It started its journey to becoming a national park by gaining attention for its hot springs in 1853. By 1885, Banff Hot Springs Reserve was established, and in 1907, the area was founded as a national park.

Its importance has been recognized by the United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) as part of the Canadian Rocky Mountain Parks World Heritage Site. It is visited by nearly 4 million tourists every year, and it's not hard to see why. At a little over an hour from Calgary and its airport, it seems remote but is fairly easy to reach by car.

Whether you're interested in hiking, skiing, camping, or just getting away, Banff is a destination with something for everyone. If you're looking to enjoy the wilderness, you have your choice of trails, lakes, and mountains. Banff National Park offers experiences for all skill levels. Among them are the often-photographed Moraine Lake, the City Pass trail, and Mount Fitzwilliam. If you're looking for a more temperate stay, Banff is home to some

of Canada's most scenic hotels. Banff Springs Hotel in particular is known for its world-class experience.

Either way, visiting Banff is like visiting a hot flow painting in real life. It's almost too photogenic. You can point a camera in practically any direction and get the perfect shot.

Much like the landscape, the weather in Banff changes throughout the year. It can be quite warm and sunny during the summer with the daytime temperature averaging around 70°F and daylight lasting until 10 p.m. However, winters can get quite cold, with an average daytime temperature of minus 10°F. So keep this

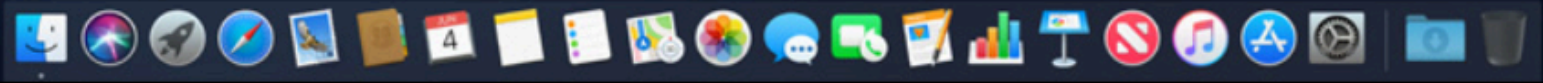
in mind if you take into planning a trip. That said, there's never really a wrong time to visit.

So season lasts more than half a year in Banff and usually goes from November to May. The snow brings with it the opportunity for activities like wildlife tours, dog sledding, glacier hikes, and much more. If you're looking to experience all the beauty that Banff has to offer, there's always the possibility of catching the Northern Lights. While it's not easy to plan around them, the lights are most common during the winter, but that doesn't mean they won't be viewable during other seasons.

When it comes to the town of Banff itself, it's a small but busy place with a population of just around 8000 people. This number changes, of course, with the constant stream of explorers, vacationers, and adventurers visiting the town and the surrounding national park. But as you might be able to tell, Banff is a little like a chosen-one-man-ubermensch place. There are resorts and spas, but there's also the chance to tough it out camping. Visitors can also go skiing, snowboarding, mountaineering, and snowmobiling.
