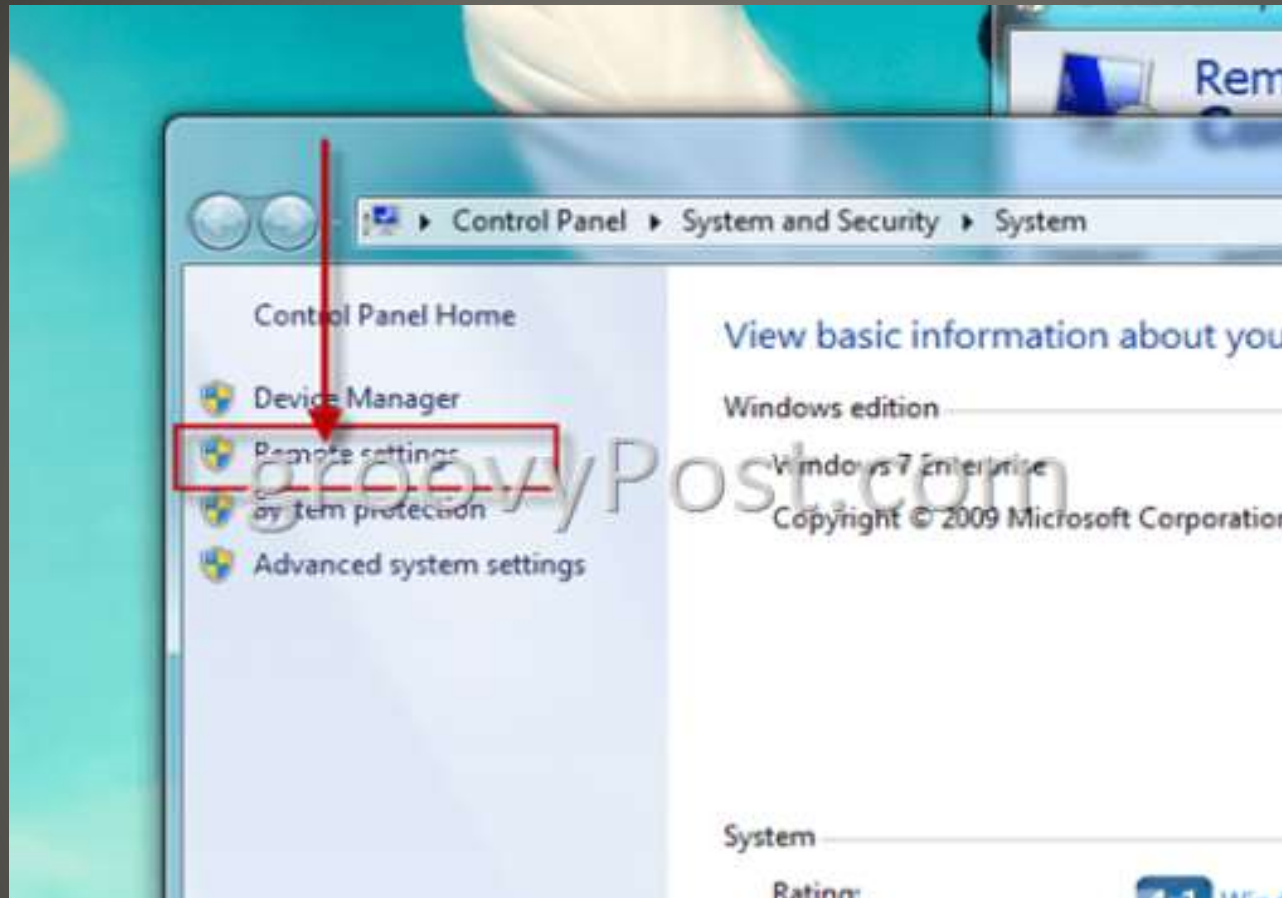


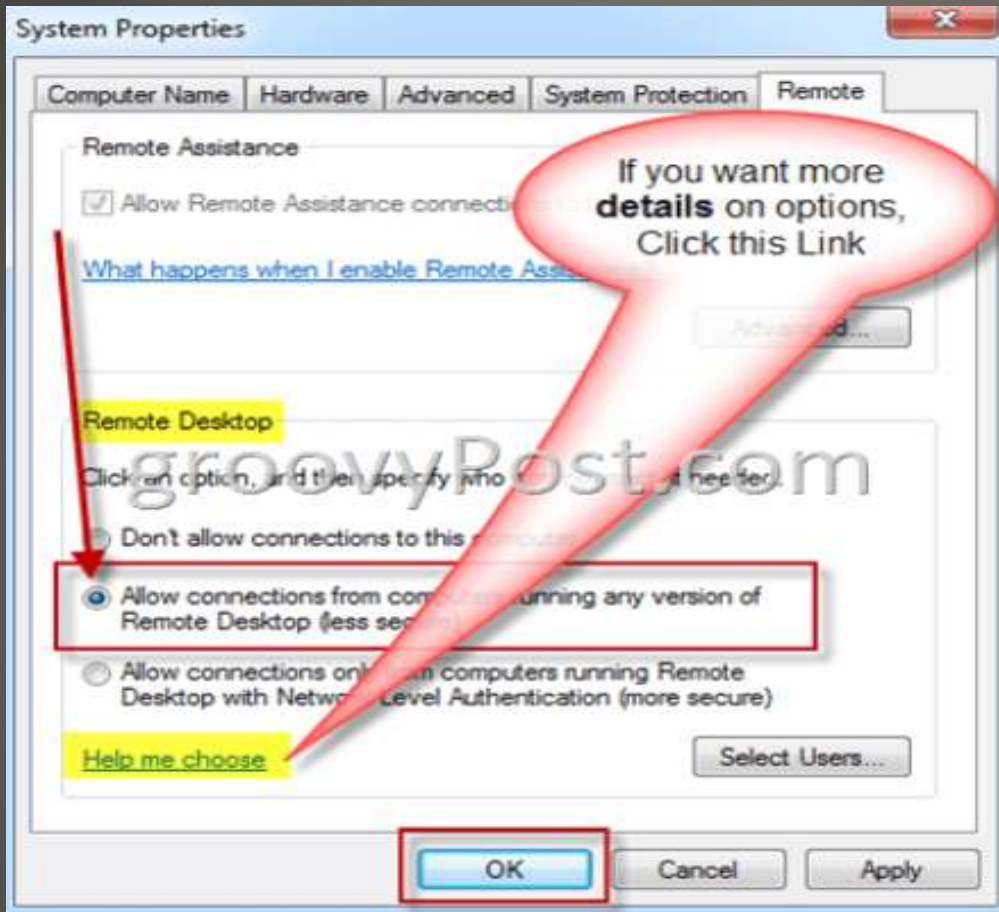
- Allows “others” to *access* your desktop

- Allow connections only from computers running Remote Desktop with Network Level Authentication (more secure)

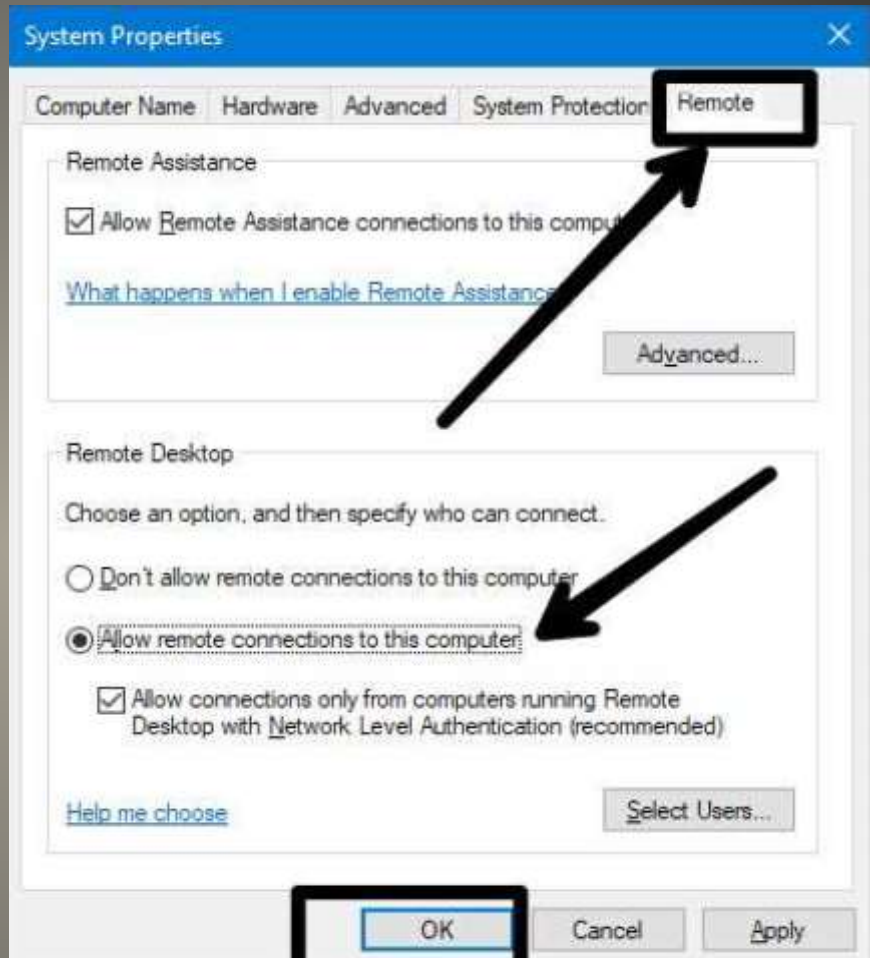
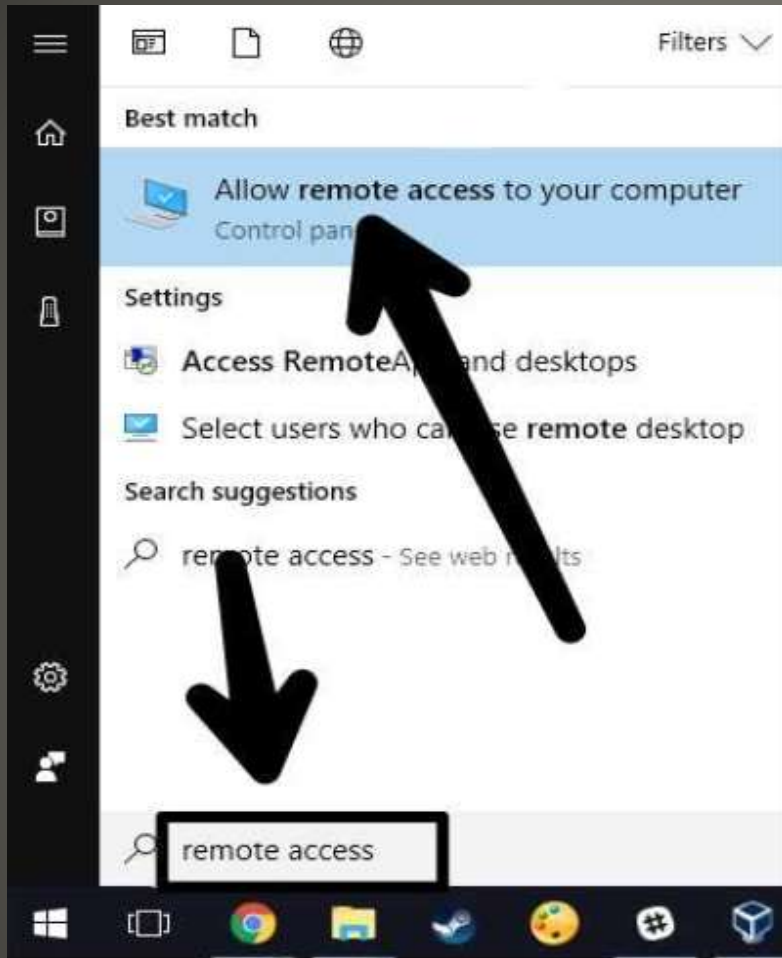
