## User Experiences with Multi-device FIDO Credentials



Allow users to automatically access their FIDO sign-in credentials (referred to by some as a "passkey") on many of their devices, even new ones, without having to re-enroll every account.

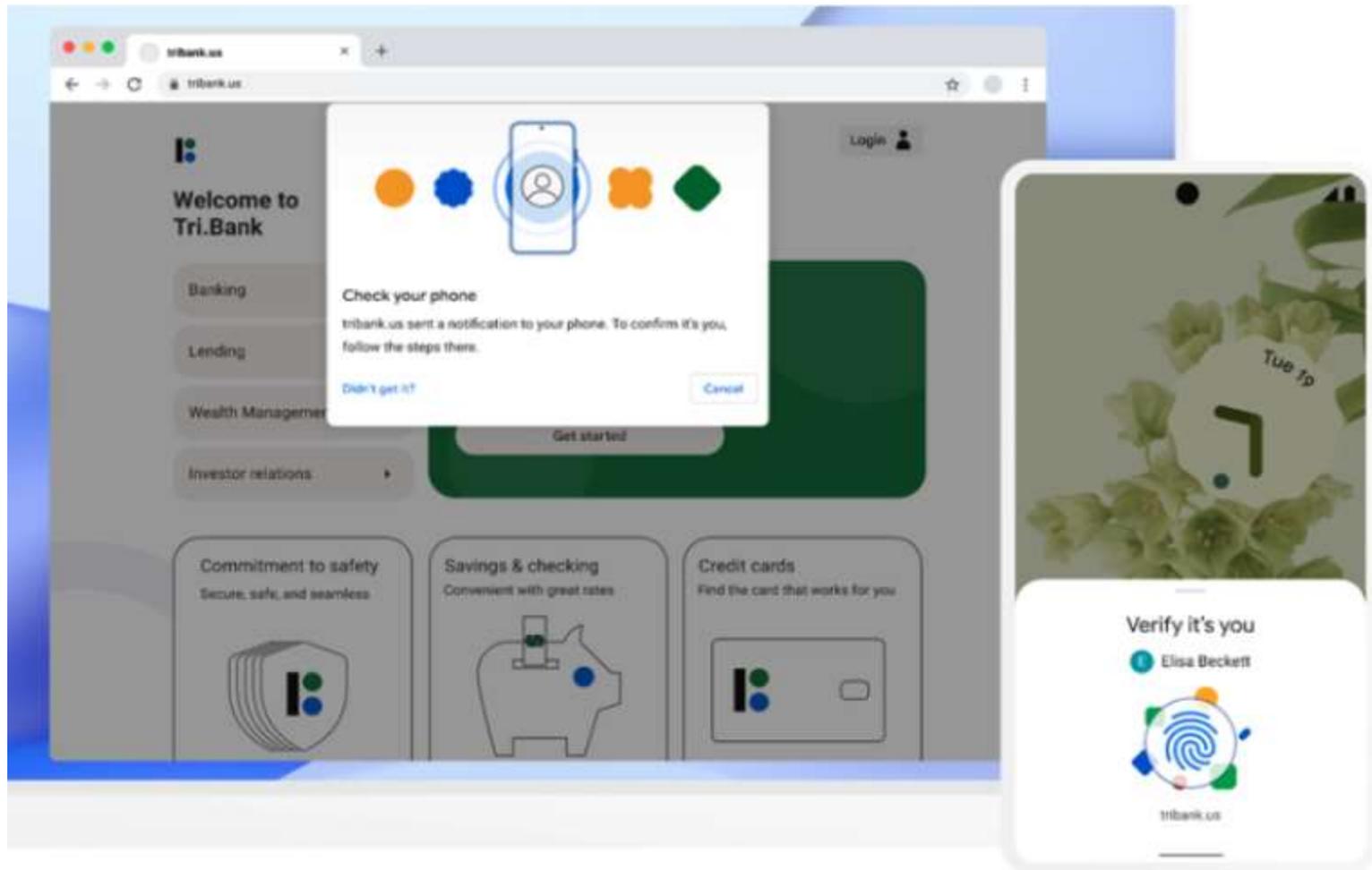


Enable users to use FIDO authentication on their mobile device to sign-in to an app or website on a nearby device, regardless of the OS platform or browser they are running.

## **NRO Anti-Fraud Handbook**

Version 2.0

"Sun City does not vet or endorse any resource or service provider in this handbook. Each resident should perform their own due diligence before choosing any service provider. This handbook is solely a compilation of resources and information to help residents deal with life challenges and maintain or improve their ability to recognize fraud and prevent becoming a victim.

Financial exploitation has been called "the crime of the 21<sup>st</sup> century" with one study suggesting that older Americans lost at least \$2.9 billion to financial exploitation by a broad spectrum of perpetrators, including persons they know and trust, as well as strangers. Cognitive impairment diminishes the ability of some older adults to make financial decisions and to detect frauds and scams.

This epidemic is under the radar. The cases tend to be very complex and can be difficult to investigate and prosecute. Elders who lose their life savings usually have little or no opportunity to regain what they have lost. Elder financial exploitation can result in the loss of the ability to live independently. It can also result in a decline in health, broken trust, and fractured families.

Awareness is the first step. Planning ahead for financial wellbeing and the possibility of diminished financial capacity is critical. Reporting and early intervention are vital to preventing loss and recovering loss when possible."

  - No Fees

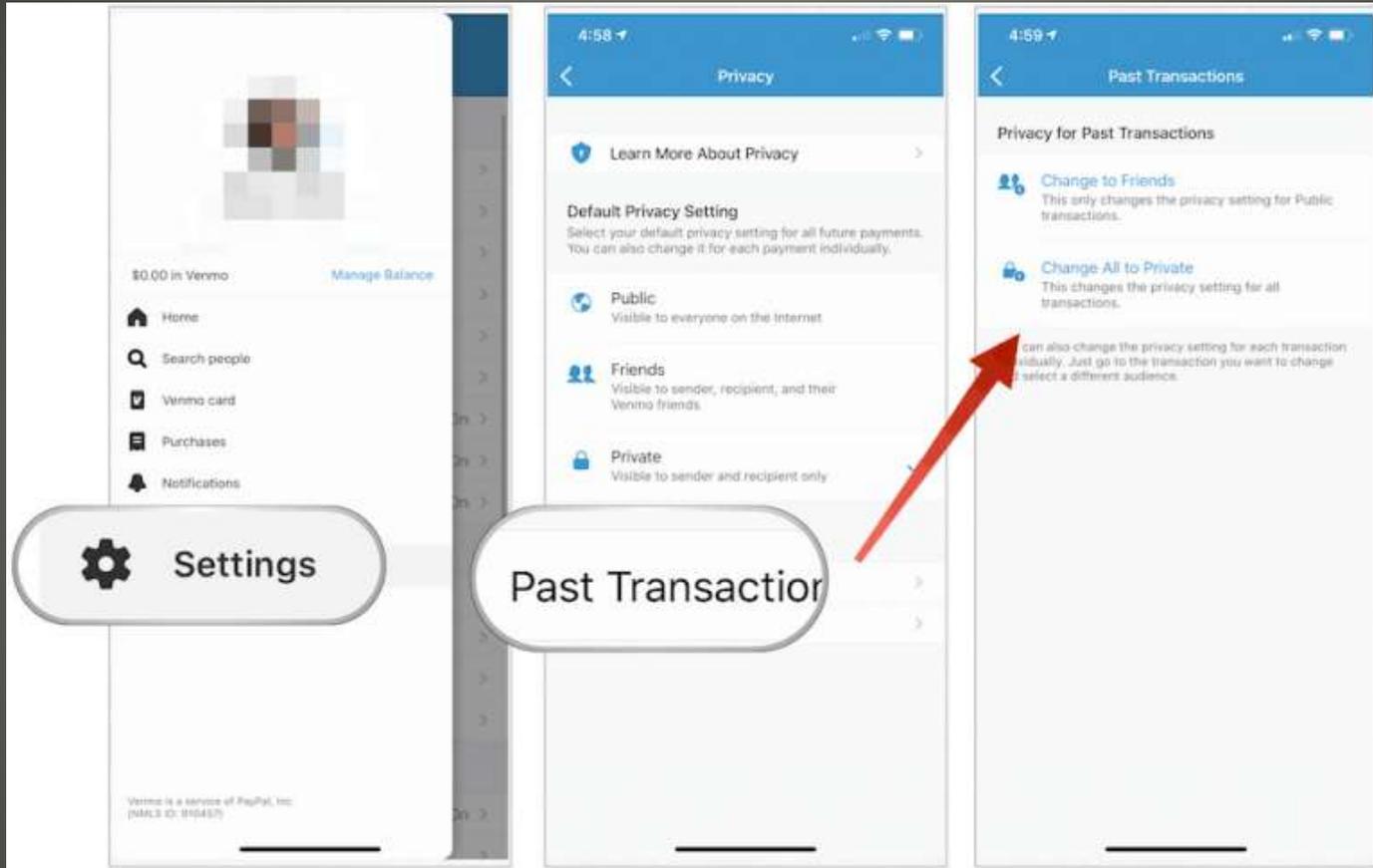

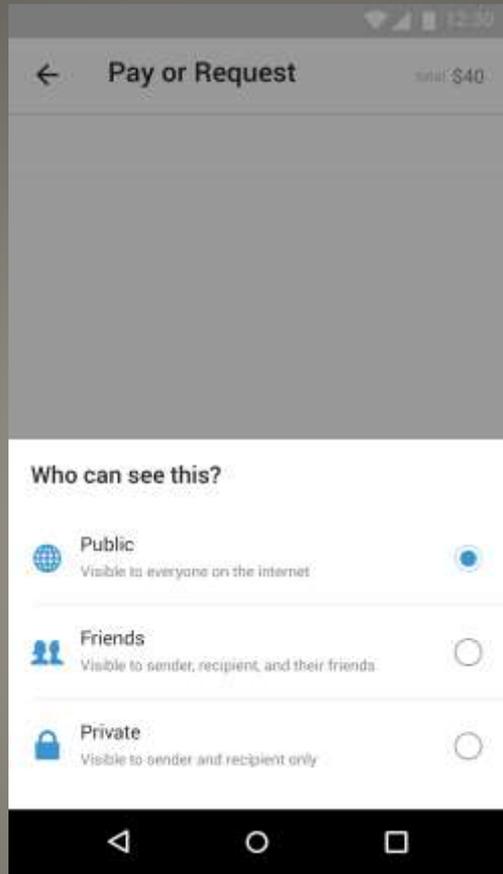

- You've dis-remembered
- Attacker finds, gets password reset or info from data breach
- MySpace
- Old but verifiable information  
Postal mail addresses, old phone numbers, etc.
- Old providers ISP, dentists, Kmart, ...

**Old and forgotten**



- No OFF - battery not easily removed
- Find My - needs power
- Bluetooth, NFC, UWB chips
  - Power for Find My
  - Power for Express Card transactions
  - Thus wired to Secure Enclave
- Bluetooth, NFC, UWB firmware not signed

Discount coupon
- Apple employees “tap-to-pay”

Secure note - Not camera roll / photos
- Photos GPS Helpful<->Harmful

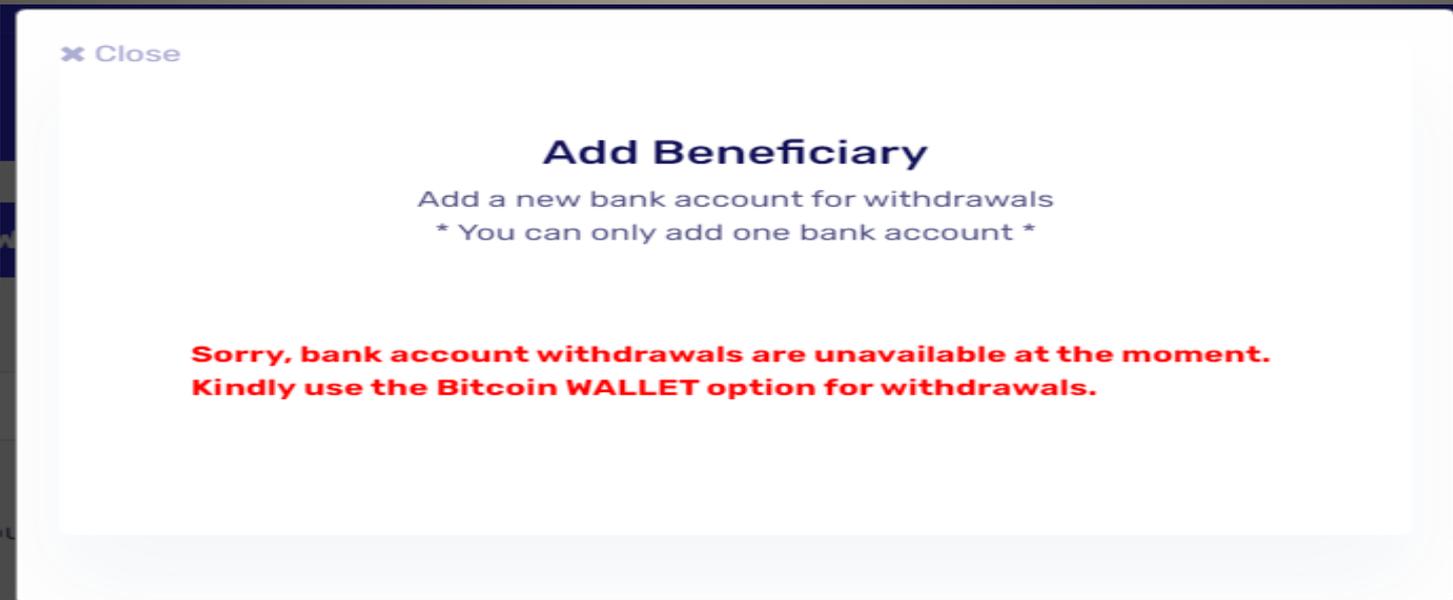

**YAN Scam – Bitcoin style**



- AH Got in - to another individual's account
- I see the 50 bitcoin
- Site forces password change, SMS MFA
- Then transfer attempts get



**YAN Scam – Bitcoin style**



- OK, I'll transfer to my wallet
  - "Sorry first transfer can be no more than 0.00001BTC, security reasons"
  - Transfer appears to be done, confirmed
  - Now transfer the 50BTC, please
  - "Sorry 30BTC is minimum transfer limit."
  - For a minimum transfer in I can get a good bit of bitcoin from a stranger's wallet

**YAN Scam – Bitcoin style**



- Passphrases
- Password theft
- Password guessing
- Password hash theft & cracking
- Unauthorized password reset / bypass
  
- Password manager
- Strong & Unique passwords
- Guard & Monitor those passwords
