got lots of experience doing tours! Founded in 1848, Georgetown has a rich history. Our current businesses were once on the path of the Chisholm Trail. NO stair climbing is required, and there will be spots to sit down during the tour. You may want to come downtown early to have dinner at Gumbo's, Wildfire, Blue Corn Harvest, 600 Degrees Pizzeria, Barrels & Amps or Roots Bistro, to name a few. There is free parking on side streets and also a free public parking lot at 297 W 2nd Street.

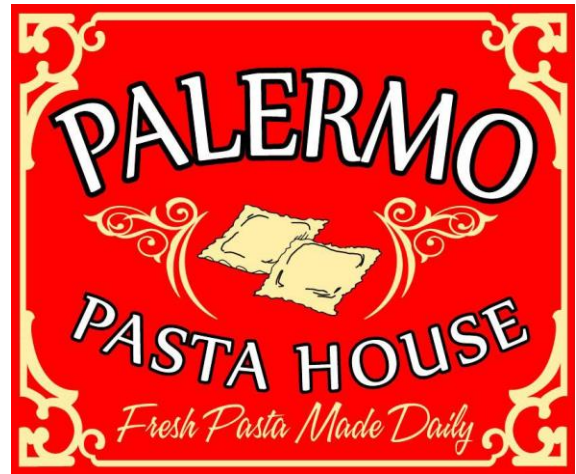
